EXAMINATION PROCEDURE USING THE EXAMUS SERVICE

- Open the link provided by your university and login to Examus system;
- On the day and time that you are scheduled for the exam click the button with the name of the test you want to pass;
- Take a photo of your identification document and send it to the proctor for verification;
- Start the exam;



TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- · A PC or a laptop (mobile devices are not supported).
- · CPU: Intel Core 2 DUO or later with SSE2 support,
- · AMD Athlon x2 or higher;
- · 2 cores and higher;
- · 1.8 GHz and higher;

- Windows 7 and higher;
- OS X Yosemite 10.10 or later;
- Ubuntu 14.04 (x64) or later,
- Debian 8 or later
- OpenSUSE 13.3 or later,

- Fedora Linux 24 or later.
- RAM: 4 GB or more; Installed browser (optional):
- Google Chrome latest version;
- Yandex Browser latest version;
- Free space on hard disk 500 MB;
- Stable internet connection;
- Internet connection speed is not less than 1 Mbps.
- Webcam with a resolution of at least 640x480 px.
- Allowed data transmission on network ports: 80 TCP, 443 TCP, 3478 TCP / UDP



WORKING WITH EXAMUS

HOW TO PREPARE THE WORKPLACE BEFORE TESTING

THE FOLLOWING STEPS MUST BE TAKEN BEFORE THE TEST:

Ensure that the room is well lit
Check your Internet connection
Make sure that the camera and microphone are turned on and the camera lens is not covered
Prepare a document for identification
Connect your laptop to the power network (battery power sometimes reduces the performance of the device)
Restart your computer for maximum performance
Make sure that your browser settings don't block 3rd party cookie
Turn off all unnecessary programs and tabs in the browser
Switch off and take away the headphones, take away the books and study notes (unless they are allowed by the exam rules)
Switch off additional monitors, additional mice and additional keyboards (if you have

• The test will appear in the window no earlier than 10 minutes before the time of the examination.





SYSTEM CHECK

The next step is checking your computer settings:

• In the pop-up window, to request access to the mic and webcam, press Allow.



• In the pop-up window, to request access to the desktop press Share.

• Wait for the completion of the checking process




IDENTIFICATION OF THE PARTICIPANT

Bring the ID document close to the webcam and press **Take a Photo**



Then press a Send button



Note: Sometimes after identification system may ask you to login again. Do not worry, the test will become available when you enter your login and password.

TESTING PROCESS

• Above the chat feed, you will see the examination rules. The active options are highlighted in colour, while the inactive options are colorless. To see the function for a respective icon, hover the mouse pointer over the icon and wait for the pop-up tip.



• If you need to hide or unhide the Examus sidebar, press the logo with the arrow to the left of the sidebar:



• Using the chat on the right side of the screen, you can communicate with the proctor throughout the exam and ask questions.

CHAT WITH PROCTOR


