BACHELOR'S DEGREE (4 years) is an undergraduate programme of higher education. The admission is open for the applicants with secondary school certificate or vocational training diploma as education background.

The academic workload usually comprises 240 credits (ECTS). After obtaining a Bachelor's degree, the graduates are eligible to continue studying as their education background.

SPECIALIST PROGRAMME (5-6 years) is a special applied programme of higher education. The admission is open for the applicants with secondary school certificate or vocational training diploma as their education background.

The academic workload usually comprises 300-360 credits (ECTS). After graduation and obtaining a Specialist's diploma, alumni are eligible to enter any postgraduate programme (Master, Ph.D., and Residency for medical students).

ENGLISH-TAUGHT BACHELOR'S AND SPECIALIST PROGRAMMES

Classes are entirely taught in English within international groups of students. Russian language is included into curriculum as a foreign language.

The required proficiency in English is B2 (upper intermediate), and language certificate is not a mandatory document for admission.

PREPARATORY COURSES

The applicants who need foundation or additional training in the Russian language and profiled disciplines can enter the preparatory courses before their degree studies.

In relevance with the future major it is possible to choose one of the following areas: Humanities, Engineering & Technology, Economics, Life & Medical Sciences, and Natural Sciences. Graduates of the programme receive an appropriate UNN certificate.

It is also possible to obtain an International Certificate of Russian Language based on the results of the official multi-level test of Russian as a Foreign Language (TORFL).



INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION WITHIN THE SCHOLARSHIPS PROVIDED BY THE RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT

1. Admission through competitive selection in your country under the quota of the Government of the Russian Federation.

Applications are submitted online & free of charge at education-in-russia.com from 1 September to 1 November (may be extended).

The results of the first stage of selection in different countries are usually announced in mid-December-March (depending on the country).

2. Privileged admission for laureates and winners of the International Olympiads held or co-organised by UNN.

The application & participation terms are to be specified by individual request to the International Admission Office.





INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION UNDER THE CONTRACT STUDIES

The intake for UNN degree programmes and foundation year on a fee-paid basis starts from April 01 and lasts until 15 August (for Russian medium programmes) and 15 September (for English medium programmes).

The applications are submitted on the UNN website via special online-platform.

Students live in student dormitories on the main campus of Lobachevsky University near the historical centre of Nizhny Novgorod.

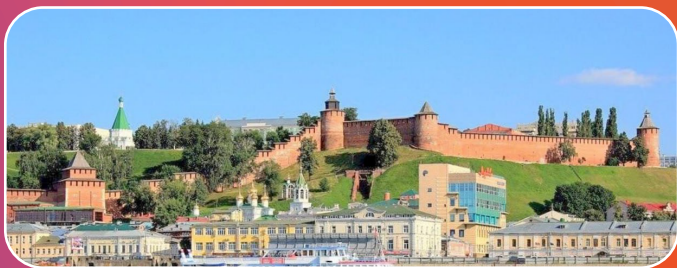


UNN has 2 types of dormitories: "corridor-type" (where common kitchens, toilets and showers are on the floor) and "apartment-type" (where students live in 2-room block apartments).



The cost of accommodation and the range of amenities depend on the type of residence chosen. By 2025, a complex of new comfortable dormitories will be built at UNN as part of the world-class IT campus "Neimark".

NIZHNY NOVGOROD



Nizhny Novgorod (formerly, from 1932 to 1990, the city of Gorky) lies 400 kilometers east of Moscow. It is the capital of the Volga Federal District and has a population of 1.3 million. Founded in 1221, the city is the closest metropolis to Moscow and one of the most important cultural, historical and industrial centres in Russia.



Known for its magnificent views of the Volga River, Nizhny Novgorod is one of the top 5 most popular tourist destinations in Russia, holding the titles of "Capital of Sunsets" and "Cultural Capital of Russia-2024".

According to the international Numbeo ranking and the e-services Rabota.ru and SberHealth, in 2024 Nizhny Novgorod was declared to be the most comfortable city in Russia to live, study and run a business.

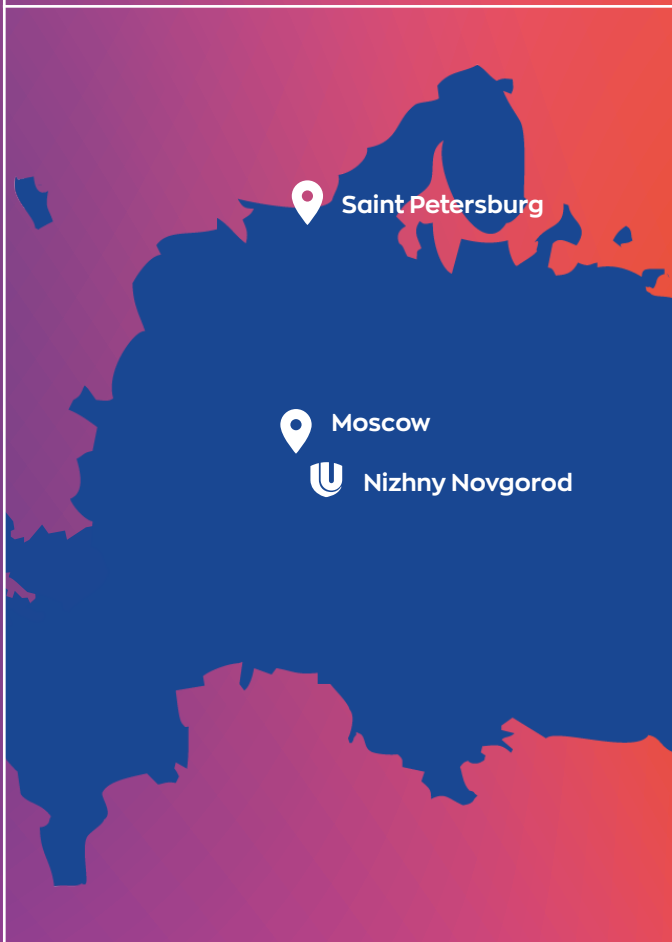
