**PORTFOLIO EVALUATION CRITERIA  
for participants of the International Olympiad  
of the Russian-African Network University**

The portfolio is scored on an 80-point scale. The maximum possible score is 80 points. When evaluating the portfolio, the jury members take the following criteria into account:

Score	Criterion	Notice
Up to 15 points	Completeness of the portfolio	The jury evaluates the completeness of the portfolio, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 points – for having a high-quality translation into Russian of a passport (or other identity document);</li> <li>• 5 points – for having a correctly filled out application form and an attached photo;</li> <li>• 5 points – for the availability of a high-quality translation into Russian of previous education documents.</li> </ul>
10 points	Previous education diploma with honors	In the absence of this practice (document category) in the country of issue of the document, a document on previous education with an average score of 90% of the maximum possible in the issuing country is taken into account.
Up to 10 points	Research activity	Points are given for participation in scientific and educational conferences at various levels (international, national, regional, university), confirmed by a certificate and related to the Olympiad profile. The score is 5 points per conference, but for no more than 2 events.
Up to 15 points	Scientific publications	Points are given for published and accepted scientific articles, monographs, and textbooks (with bibliographic data) related to the Olympiad profile – 5 points per publication, but for no more than 3 publications.
10 points	Intellectual property	Points are given for patents and inventions, but for no more than one patent or invention.
5 points	Professional expertise	Points are given for work experience (length of service) of at least 2 years in a profession related to the Olympiad profile.
Up to 5 points	Creative, athletic, and social activities	Points are given (1 point per documented achievement, but for no more than 5 achievements): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• for active participation in social projects (work in student associations, student government bodies, volunteering, etc.);</li> <li>• for creative and athletic achievements (achieved during university studies and/or within 3 years prior to the Olympiad);</li> <li>• for active participation in events of the Russian-African Network University (RAFU) organized by RAFU member universities.</li> </ul>
10 points	Participation in Olympiads held by Russian universities	For participation in student Olympiads (winners and awardees of the final stage) organized by Russian universities.
