**THE STRUCTURE OF THE PORTFOLIO
of the participants of the International Olympiad
of the Russian-African Network University**

1. After registering for the RAFU Olympiad at the provided links (Russian: <http://www.unn.ru/site/olimp/rafu-olympiad/>; English: <http://eng.unn.ru/olimp/rafu-olympiad-eng/>) and receiving confirmation via email from the organizing committee, participants must send the following documents to rafu-olympiad@unn.ru:

1	a copy of your passport or other identity document	<p>A valid international passport, preferably with a validity period of at least 2 years.</p> <p>An international passport with a shorter validity period, or an internal passport/identity card, may also be submitted. In such cases, the candidate must be prepared to obtain or renew an international passport required for entry into the Russian Federation for study purposes.</p> <p>If the document is not in Russian, a certified translation into Russian must be provided.</p>
2	higher education documents	<p>A bachelor's degree diploma and its supplement with grades (transcript). Holders of foreign specialist or master's degrees may also participate in the Olympiad.</p> <p>Participants holding a specialist or master's degree issued in the Russian Federation are not eligible to participate in the Olympiad.</p> <p>If the participant is completing their studies at the university this year, they must provide a certificate of education along with an extract of grades or another document showing their current academic performance.</p> <p>If the document (or any part thereof, such as a seal) is not in Russian, a translation into Russian is required.</p>
3	personal achievement documents	<p>Diplomas and certificates of achievements in various fields (with the exception of certificates of completion of online courses) received no earlier than 3 years before the year of the Olympiad.</p>
4	CV application form	<p>Completed in accordance with the form established by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation (the form will be sent by the Organizing Committee via email).</p> <p>The application must be filled out electronically in .doc/.docx format.</p> <p>A color "passport-style" photo of the candidate on a light background in .jpg/.png format must be attached to the application.</p>
5	consent to the processing of personal data	<p>Completed in accordance with the form established by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation (the form will be sent by the Organizing Committee via email).</p>

		The form must be submitted as a scanned copy (in .pdf format), completed by hand and signed by the participant. The form may be filled out either entirely in Russian or entirely in English.
